Summary of Financial Position

- Holy Trinity PTA had £36,051 in the bank as at 1st September 2022.
- Of this, £32,722 was 'restricted' (allocated funds), therefore leaving £3,329 unallocated.
- Additional restricted funds are required for 2023-2024 and the amount in yet to be confirmed.
- Money raised in September 2022 to August 2023 was £25,543
- Money spent in September 2022 to August 2023 was £15,950. Therefore the surplus raised was £9,593.
- All PTA spending requires a trustee vote whether to go ahead or not.
- Funding for a much needed second SEN room at school and funding for the Year 5 Opera Brava require a trustee vote imminently and would benefit so many of the children at school.
